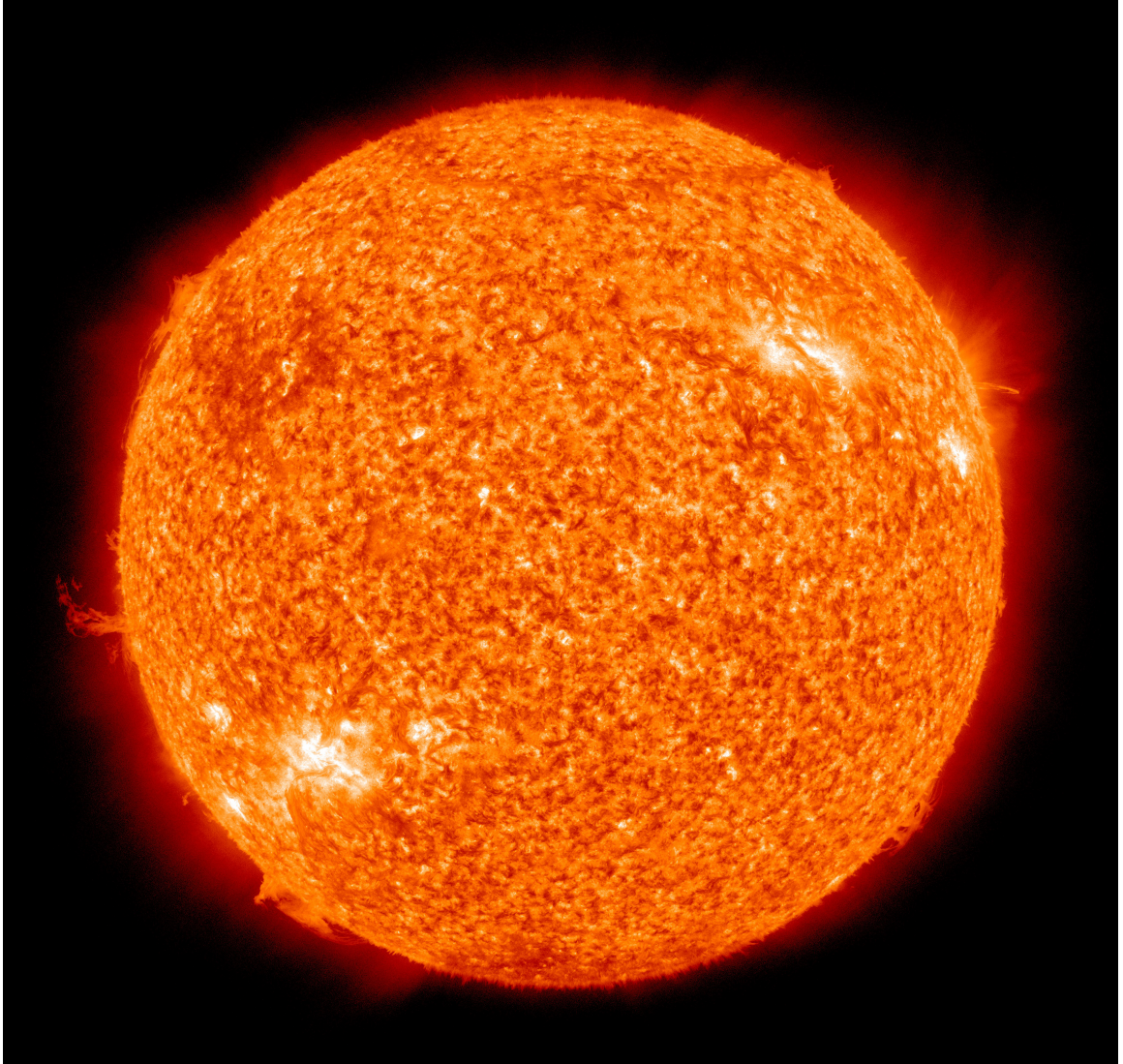


Figure 2.1: A picture of the sun
